Congregate Meals were provided at Mesa Active Adult Center, Red Mountain Active Adult Center, and Apache Junction Active Adult Center throughout the fiscal year. Over 37,000 congregated meals were provided. In addition to nutritious meals, approximately 4,400 activity sessions with over 54,000 participant contacts were conducted in areas that included exercise / dance, health promotion, creative arts, life-long learning, and games / entertainment.

Home Delivered Meals provided 89,700 nutritious meals for over 1,000 unduplicated isolated homebound older or disabled adults, coupled with essential wellness checks. Options include Home Delivered Meals (subsidized weekday hot meal program), Meals for You (private pay weekday hot meal program), and Transitional Meals (frozen short-term meals).

Food Services enabled the organization to provide elements of quality core programs in partnership with other organizations. FY-2017 contracts included the provision of nutritious catered meals for neighboring senior centers (Tempe Community Action Agency).

After a period of organizational evaluation, the East Valley Adult Resources (EVAR) Board of Directors made the difficult decision to transition from the role as lead provider of senior services at the Apache Junction Active Adult Center. EVAR supported the transition of services to long-time partners, the Pinal Gila Council for Senior Citizens and the City of Apache Junction, as of November 2016. EVAR prepared meals for the Apache Junction Center for the remainder of the fiscal year through a catering services agreement with Pinal Gila Council for Senior Citizens. EVAR continues to offer Outreach / Social Services, Home Care, and Volunteer Services Programs for Apache Junction residents. The EVAR Board of Directors also decided to sunset the agency's provision of the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP), effective September 2016.
